

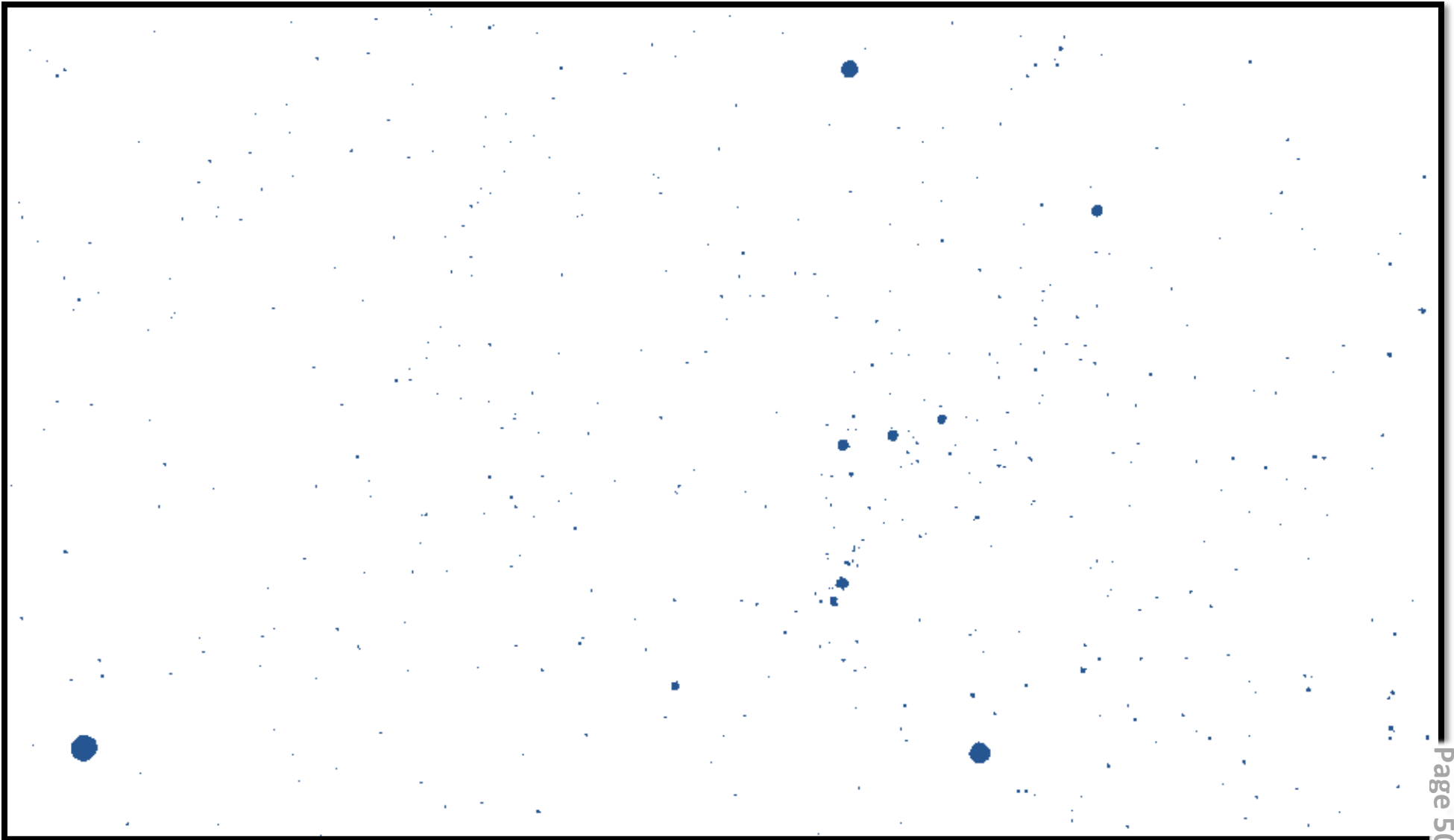

# Constellations

*Look to the south in the February night sky around 8:00pm and this is what you'll see. On a clear night with no moon, you might see hundreds of stars, but 10 of them will be brighter than the rest. Use all or some of the 10 stars to draw your own constellation below.*
